Northern Sparsely Populated Areas

~ 2,6 million people (0,5% of EU28) on ~ 532 000 square km (10% of EU28 area) Average of about 5 inhabitants/square kilometer (116 for EU in average)

= As if spreading the population of Rome over entire Spain



Consists of 14 regions in **northern Sweden** and **Finland** within the EU and **Norway** within the EEA.

Mostly rural (forests and mountains), but also consisting of some larger cities between 50.000 and up to 200.000 inhabitants.

A main part of the European Arctic and also being the Arctic regions within the EU.





OECD looks at the NSPA

- Vulnerable societies due to lack of critical mass, demography and small economic trade/export dependent base (= need of external support)
- Accounting for the higher unit costs of delivering public services and key growth factors below national levels; such as infrastructure, skills and capital market (= need of investments)
- NSPA is of increasing economic and geo-political importance and deliver substantial contribution to the countries net export (= Raw Materials, Arctic, Russia)
- National an EU policies need to overall be better adapted to each regions specificities (= truly contribute to the unique innovation system)
- Identify absolute advantages in tradeable niches to step up in the value chains, using regional Smart Specialisation, making challenges to opportunities (= natural assets, winter test, tourism, e-health, process-IT, bio economy...)


"Finn Fem Fel!" (= spot the difference game!)

So called "Strong Men" weakening the multilateral world the EU is so dependent on. EU today only having soft power in the toolbox, over time becoming relatively smaller.















EU innovation score board


Umeå University is a driver for sure
